Theme of the Seminar:

India is home to diverse cultures, costume, cuisine, languages and geographical terrine. Indian economy is ascribed as one of the fastest growing economies across the globe. It has almost 17% share of global population, with only 2.4 per cent of geographical area and 4 per cent of global water resources. Sooner or later it is expected to stand closer to China in terms of population or even surpass it by 2031. It is predominantly an agrarian economy. Though, nearly 45 ner cent of the work force finds their levelihood in primary sector, its contribution to GDP is hovering around mere 14 per cent. It only emphasizes the bare reality that primary sector is the major cause of concern for the policy makers as the work force depended on it is reeling under abject poverty. Most worrying factor is that number of farm community is fast dwindling while the number of farm labourers is on the rise. Only emphasizing that fact that farming has become unviable and therefore majority of them are moving out of farm sector. Economy is growing at a significant rate, it is primarily being contributed by the secondary and tertiary sector growth. Unfortunately, these two sectors have not been able to release the surplus work force from farm sector. Unfortunately, our growth has been primarily jobless growth.

There has been a vast rift between growth and development in India. It is studied that, I per cent of population in India is having hold. over 70 per cent of wealth in the country. We can imagine the kind of grave income inequalities that are present in our country. Though the economic growth is growing at a faster rate, unfortunitely the growth has not been getting translated into development. As per the 2018 Global Hunger Index, India is ranked at 103rd position, which is 6 positions down from 2017. The most worrying thing is that, India's GHI is far behind the most war torn and backward countries like Iraq, Ethiopia and Botswana...etc., Even if we take Human Development Index (HDI) - 2018, we are far behind many of our Asian neighbours like China, Sri lanka, Thailand, etc. It only establishes the fact that India is yet to achieve significant progress on the socio-economic fronts.

If we look at the 'Labour Force Participation Rate (LFPR) in India'. it is only 53.8 per cent in December 2017. LFPR in many of the developing countries is much higher, namely Indonesia- 70% and Kenya - 73%. If we take women LFPR, it is one of the lowest in the world, standing at just 26%. At the same time, if we look at the trends in employment in India, 95 per cent of the work force is organized in unorganized sector and only 5 per cent are in organized sector. As per the 'National Commission for Enterprises in Unorganised Sector (NCEUS)", the livelihood status of work force cogaged in unorganized sector is very much deplorable. They do not cojoy any job certainty with no assured wage levels, not covered under any social security not initiatives. Apart from that they are exposed to various physical hazards at work place, no burgaining power, no need to mention the kind of verbal abuse that they

Therefore, in this buckdrop, we intend to bring out an intense discussion and debate so as to examine the prospects and challenges of unorganized sector in India.




