World AIDS Day takes place on 1 December each year. Department of Commerce along with Consumer Club of Sri A.S.N.M. Government College (A), Palakol has celebrated ‘Consumer Day’ in e-Classroom on 24th December, 2020 on the eve of National “Consumer Day”. Every year, 24th of December is observed as a National Consumer Day in India. On this day the Consumer Protection Act, 1986 had received the assent of the President and came into effect. The Act aims to provide consumers with effective safeguards against different types of exploitation, such as defective goods, deficiency in services and unfair trade practices.

The objective was to familiarize and sensitise the students and the faculty members towards the consumer rights and redressal mechanism available at various levels and to inculcate them healthy personal and social attitudes and behaviour towards the consumerism. It was observed to

highlight the importance of the consumer movement and the need to make every consumer more aware of their rights and responsibilities

This year the National Consumer Day is celebrated with the theme
"The Sustainable Consumer".

In this programme Dr.D.Giri, the Principal of the College acted as a Chairperson, Sri D.V. Raghu Vamsy, Advocate, Supreme Court of India, New Delhi as a Chief Guest, and Sri Sri Rama Murthy, Vice Principal of the College as a special Invitee, Dr.K.Sudhakara Rao, Coordinator of IQAC & Consumer Club as an organising secretary and all the staff members and the students have participated.

The Chairperson of the programme has said in his opening remarks, every individual is a consumer and knowingly or unknowingly we are buying the goods and availing the services from various suppliers. We have seen technology is updating day by day and selling and buying methods also changing drastically, particularly, digital marketing. While we are purchasing goods on e-commerce platform, no physical touch with product and no physical discussion/contact with suppliers, we have seen virtually and buying it. Many consumers have been deceived because of the suppliers adopted unfair trade practices. Therefore, everyone should aware the existing rules and regulations pertaining to protect ourselves.

Naga Mani a students from the Final B.Com (General) revealed that why we have been celebrating this National Consumer Day on December 24th every year and she said what are the importance to celebrate this as a national event. Another student Durga Prasad from the Final B.Com (General) told the consumer rights as per Consumer Protection Act, those are;

"Right to Safety

Right to Information

Right to Choose

Right to Hearing

Right to Redress

Right to Education"

Sri Rama Murthy, Vice Principal of the College has said that this is very important topic in the present days, everyone must know the legal aspects of consumer protection irrespective of staff or students, science or arts, even general public also must aware. To protect ourselves as a consumer we have to update from time to time as per the changes in the legal aspects relating to consumers.

Dr.K.Sudhakara Rao, Coordinator of IQAC & Consumer Club said that who is the consumer and as a consumer what are the dos & donts while buying the goods and the services. He has explained in detail regarding to various forums like District, State and National.If a consumer will be deceived, then he will approach the various forums as per latest Consumer Protection Act, 2019 like;

District Commission: complaints where the value of the goods or services paid as consideration does not exceed Rs.1 crore;

State Commission: exceeds Rs.1 crore, but does not exceed Rs.10 crore;

National Commission: exceeds Rs.10 crore.

The Chief Guest Sri D.V. Raghu Vamsy, Advocate, Supreme Court of India, New Delhi stated that the latest Consumer Protection Act, 2019 updated as per the requirements of the present conditions to protect the consumer at most care, this act implemented w.e.f. July 2020. He said as per the old Consumer Protection Act, 1986, no separate regulator, No provision on e-Commerce Sites and no legal provision for Mediation Cells. But in the revised Act, 2019 Central Consumer Protection Authority (CCPA) to be formed as a regulator, all rules of direct selling are extended to e-commerce and court can refer settlement through Mediation Cells.

Consumer awareness is a need of present days. The team of Consumer Club educated the students and the faculty members and made them aware of their rights as a consumer, about their safety and the redressal options available to them as per the Act, rules and regulations enforced and informed the effective safeguards against different types of exploitation. They informed about advertisements how they are misleading and making fool to the consumers. They informed about different labels and marks which give authentication to the products and services and how they are different from their counterparts.

HISTORY OF WORLD COCONUT DAY

We are just coconuts for coconuts on World Coconut Day. The aim of celebrating this holiday is to bring coconuts into the spotlight and recognize their importance and benefits — not just health-wise but economically too. Coconuts are especially celebrated in Asian- and

Pacific regions by the APCC, Asian and Pacific Coconut Community, which facilitates most of the coconut production centers.

The coconut's adorable name has an interesting origin. As portrayed in many cartoons and children's illustrations, there are three indentations on the surface of a coconut, which resemble a human face. Ancient Iberian folklore tells us that when the Portuguese and Spanish explorers saw these indentations, it reminded them of the bogeyman or a similar entity.
