Members of the Board of Studies of Commerce Department met on 23-11-2022 under the chairmanship of Dr.K.Madhu Shalini, Head of the Department of Commerce. The members discussed and resolved the following for the Academic Year 2021-22 based on the agenda points.

AGENDA:

1. To prescribe the syllabus for (all) Semesters of B.Com (General and Computer Applications), BBA for the academic year 2021-22
2. To incorporate any additional Inputs into the Curriculum where ever (is) necessary.
3. To split the marks categorically between the internal assessment and the semester end examinations.
4. To fix the pattern of Internal Assessment Components.
5. To approve the Blueprint and model question papers for theory and other examinations, wherever is applicable for both internal and semester end examinations.
6. To identify the faculty members for the paper settings, valuation work and viva-voce examinations for theory and project work.
7. To approve the Course Codes and Outcomes of Programme & Courses
8. To approve any other Academic Activities of the department.

RESOLUTIONS:

1. It is resolved to follow the same syllabus, which was approved by the BOS for the academic year 2020-21, for the Ist B.Com (General) English and Telugu medium and Ist B.Com (CA) English medium for the admitted batch 2021-22. If the revised syllabus will be introduced by the affiliating University for the academic year 2021-22, it will be reviewed and adopted through the constitution of internal committee and will be ratified in the upcoming BOS.
2. Resolved to follow the Choice Based Credit System syllabi prescribed by Adikavi Nannaya University, Rajamahendravaram for II B.Com (General) English and Telugu Medium and II B.Com (CA) English Medium (i.e. admitted batch 2020-21).
3. It is resolved to approve the proposed syllabus for III B.Com (General) English and Telugu Medium and III B.Com (CA) English Medium for the academic year 2021-22.
4. It is resolved to approve the incorporation of additional inputs into the curriculum to enrich the students' knowledge wherever is necessary.

5. It is resolved to approve the break-up of marks between internal and external assessment, i.e. the continuous internal assessment for 25 marks as well as semester end examination for 75 marks and those will be consolidated for 100 marks for each course.

7. Resolved that the marks for the semester end examination is 75 and pass mark will be 26. The candidate should get minimum 40 marks to pass in a particular course in all together of internal and semester end examinations. There are no minimum marks to be required for internal assessment.

8. It is resolved to approve the pattern of question papers for the internal and semester end examinations for all courses in the following manner;

Internal written Examination (Total Marks = 15):

i. In Section-I, the candidate has to answer any one short answer question out of two Questions each carries 5 marks;
Marks = $1 \times 5 = 5$.

ii. In Section-II, the candidate has to answer any one question out of two questions each carries 10 marks;
Marks = $1 \times 10 = 10$

Sem End Examinations (Total Marks = 75):

i. In section-I, the candidate has to answer any five short answer questions out of eight questions each carries 5 marks;
Marks = $5 \times 5 = 25$.

ii. In Section-II, the candidate has to answer five questions from a total of ten questions with internal choice each carries 10 marks;
Marks = $5 \times 10 = 50$
