<b>Values achieved</b>	The results further highlighted that although cyber victimization and perpetration and traditional bullying victimization and perpetration positively correlated with anxiety, depression, lower self-esteem, suicidal ideation, absenteeism and leaving school early, victimization in both types of bullying.

Always be respectful and friendly to others on social media, and report any bullying or hurtful behavior to a grown-up or the platform's moderators.
