The programme was inaugurated with a welcome speech by Dr V. Yamini. She spoke about the significance of National Pollution Control Day. Principal Dr T. She explained that the day is dedicated to encourage the adoption of pollution control acts to prevent the environmental pollution caused by human and industrial administration negligence.
