The program fostered a sense of unity and mutual respect between male and female staff members, enhancing the work environment and promoting gender inclusivity.

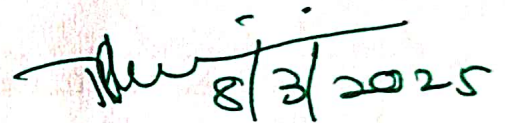
The event served as a platform to honor and appreciate the relentless efforts of women staff—teaching, non-teaching, and support workers—boosting their morale and sense of belonging.
