III SEMESTER RESULTS, NOV 2025

The **III Semester End Examinations** were conducted successfully from **13th November 2025 to 20th November 2025** for **201 registered students**. A total of **46 question papers** covering various Major, Minor, and Skill Enhancement courses were set by eminent external subject experts, ensuring fairness, quality, and confidentiality in the examination process.

Out of the **201 registered students**, **199 students appeared** for the examinations. The answer scripts were evaluated by experienced faculty members through the **Central Valuation** process, which was completed over a period of **11 days**. 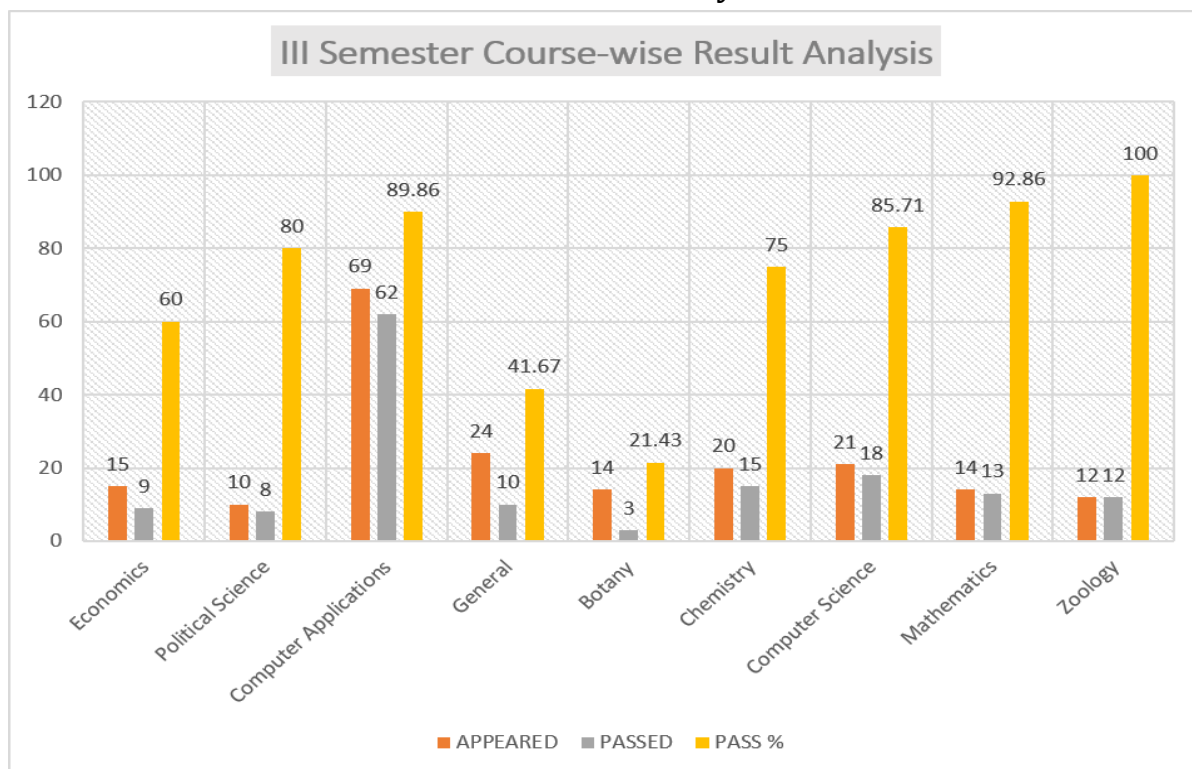

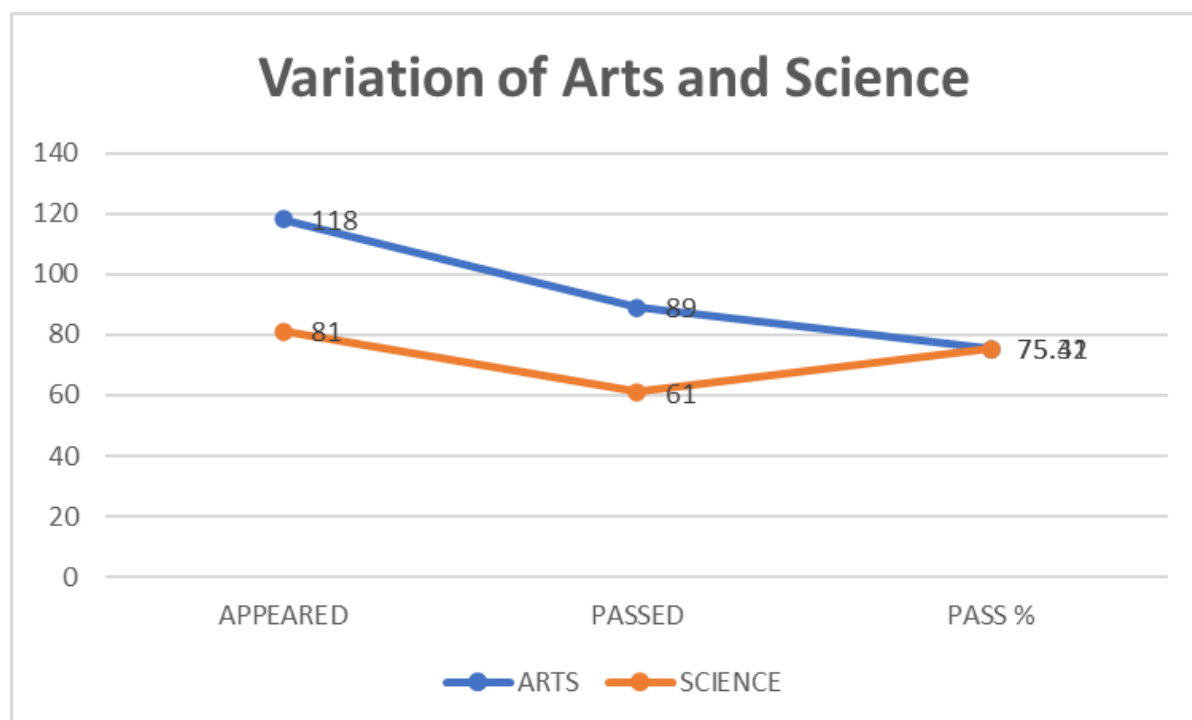

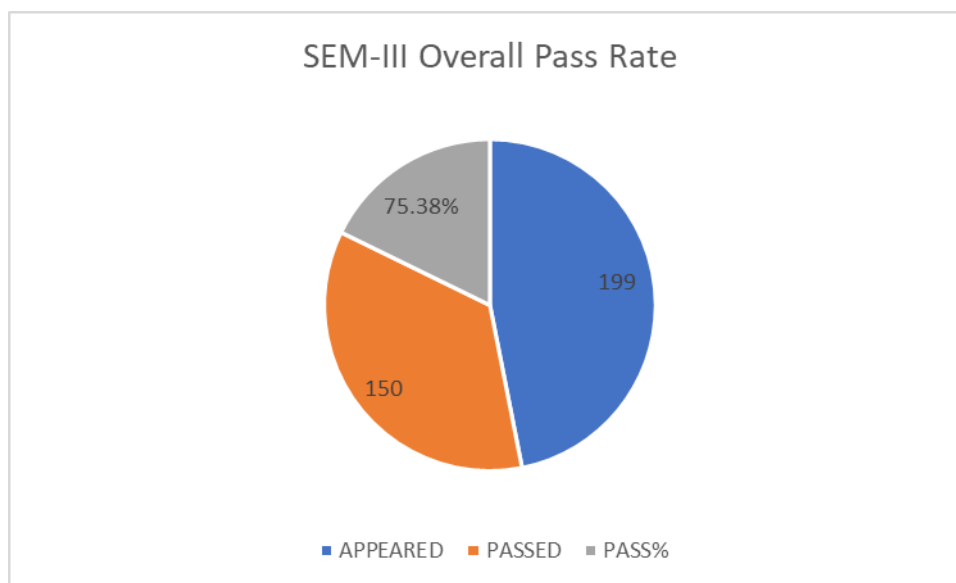
Variation of Arts and Science

Highlights on Performance – UG II Year III Semester Results (November 2025)

- The **UG II Year III Semester Examinations** recorded an **overall pass percentage of 75.38%**, with **150 students passing out of 199 students who appeared**.
- **B.Com. Computer Application** emerged as the best-performing programme with an overall pass percentage of **89.86%**.

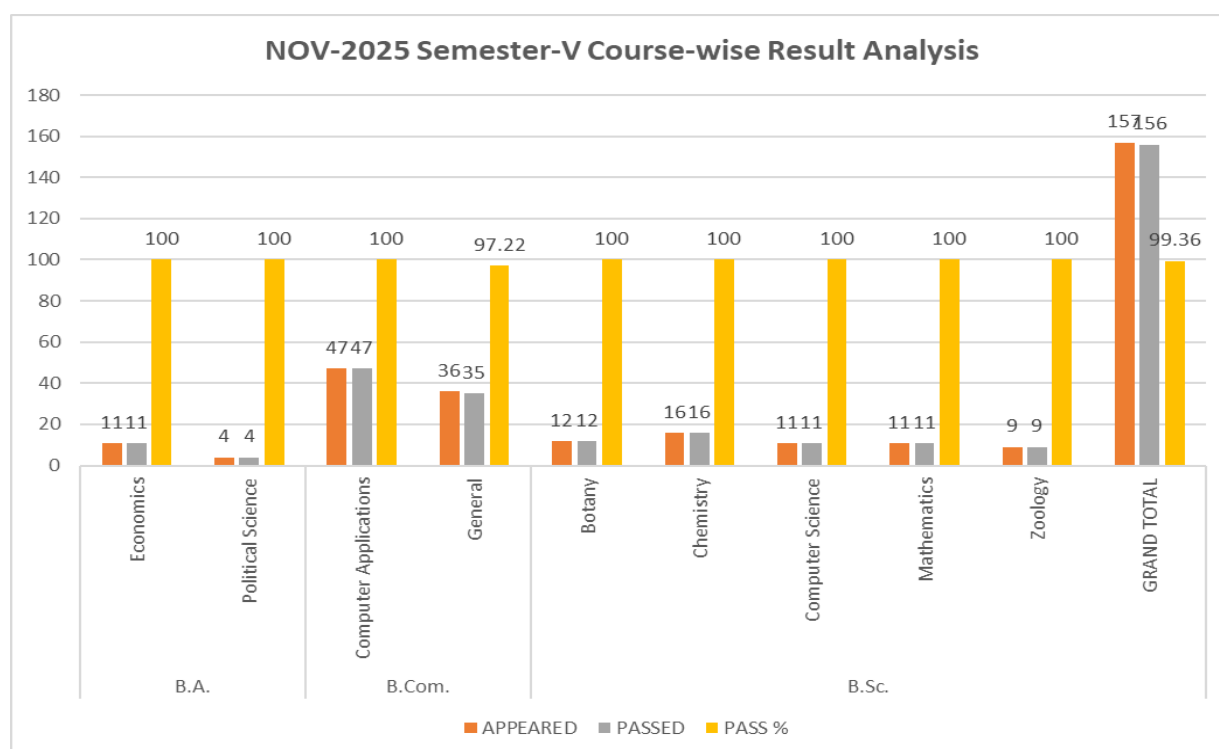

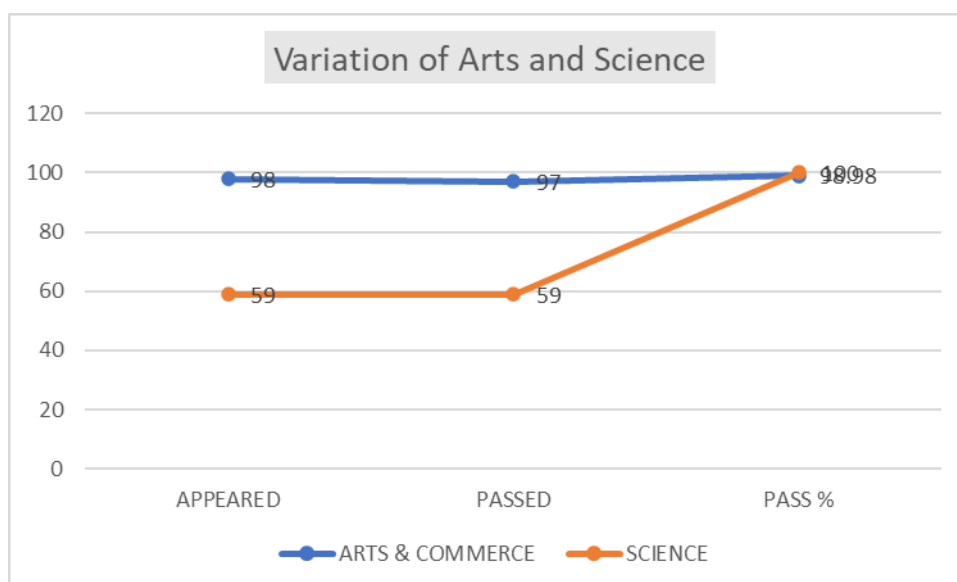

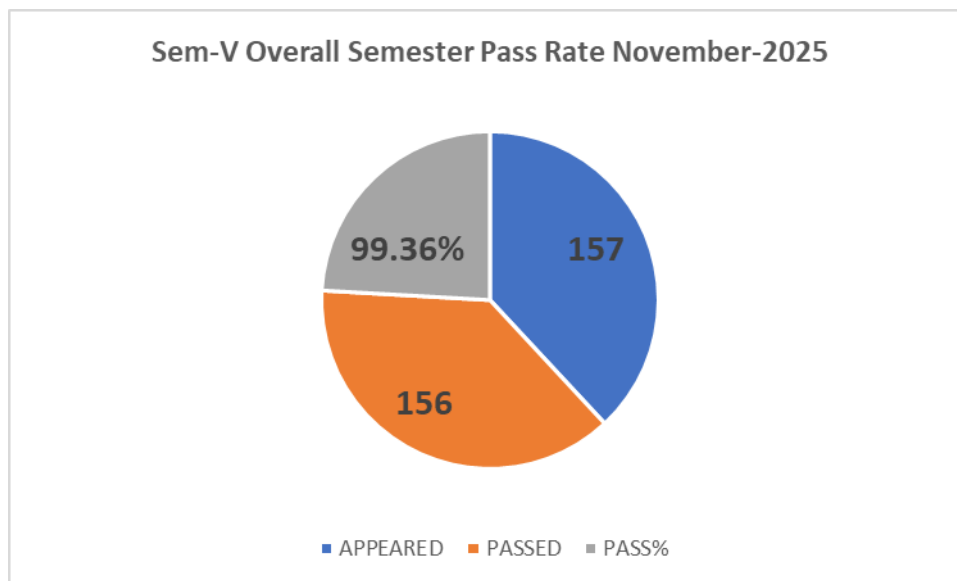
Variation of Arts and Science

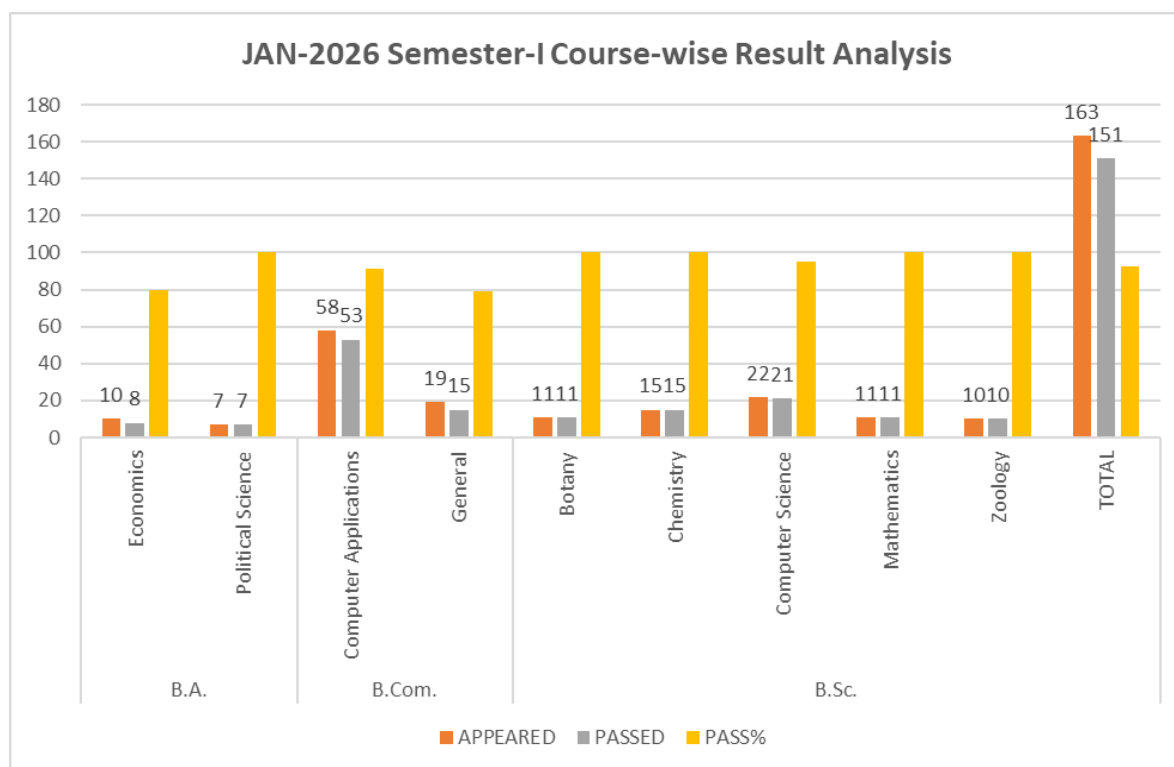

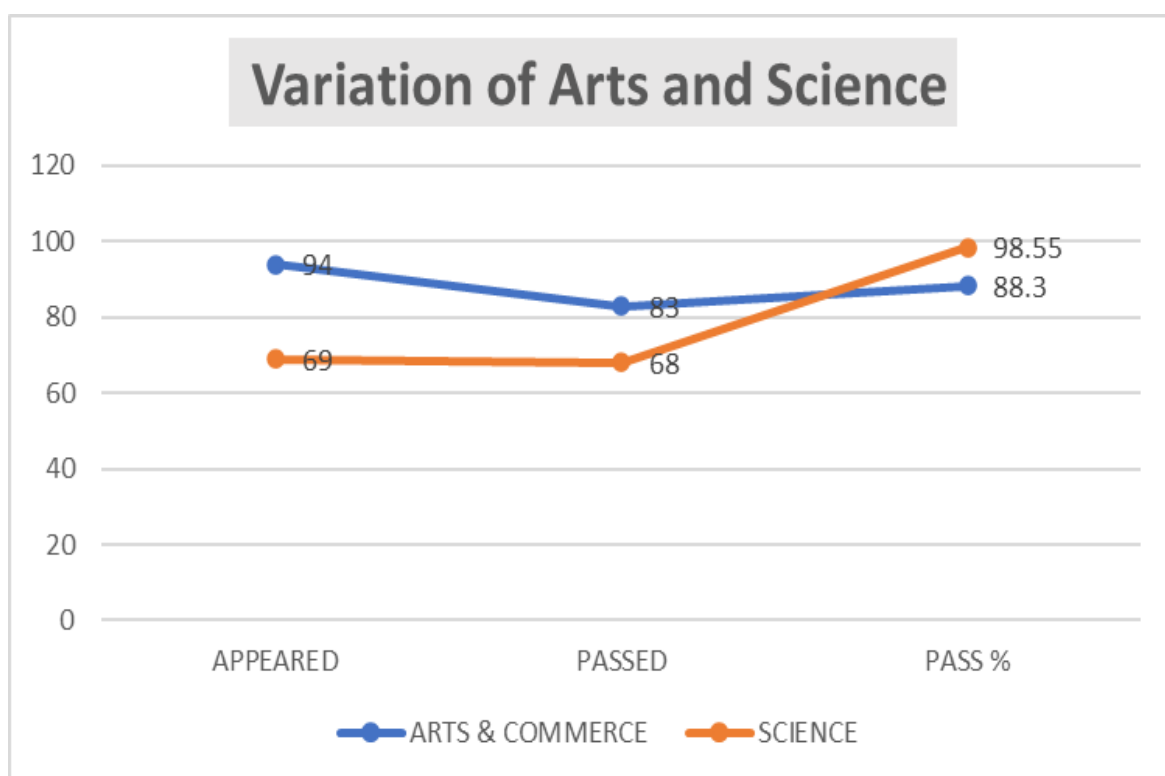

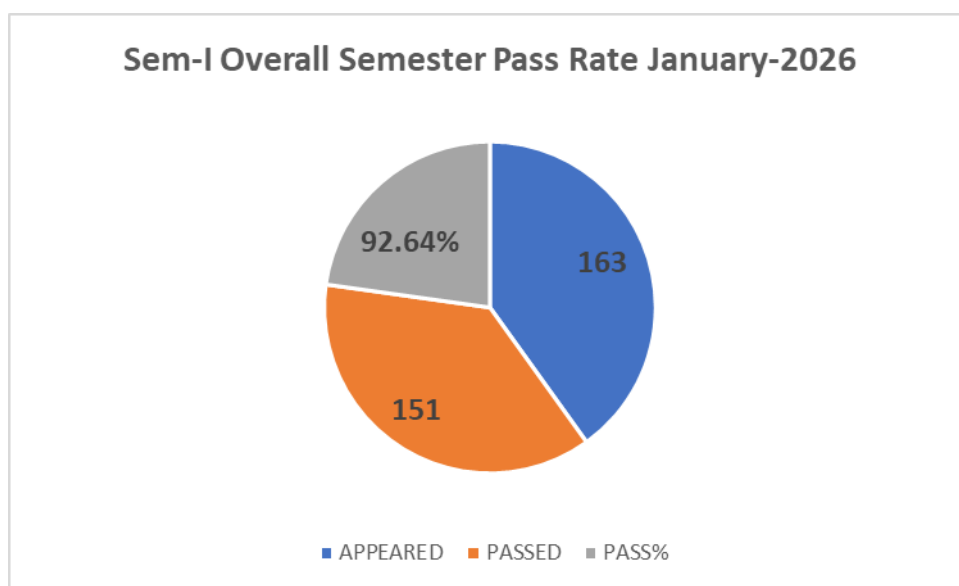
Variation of Arts and Science

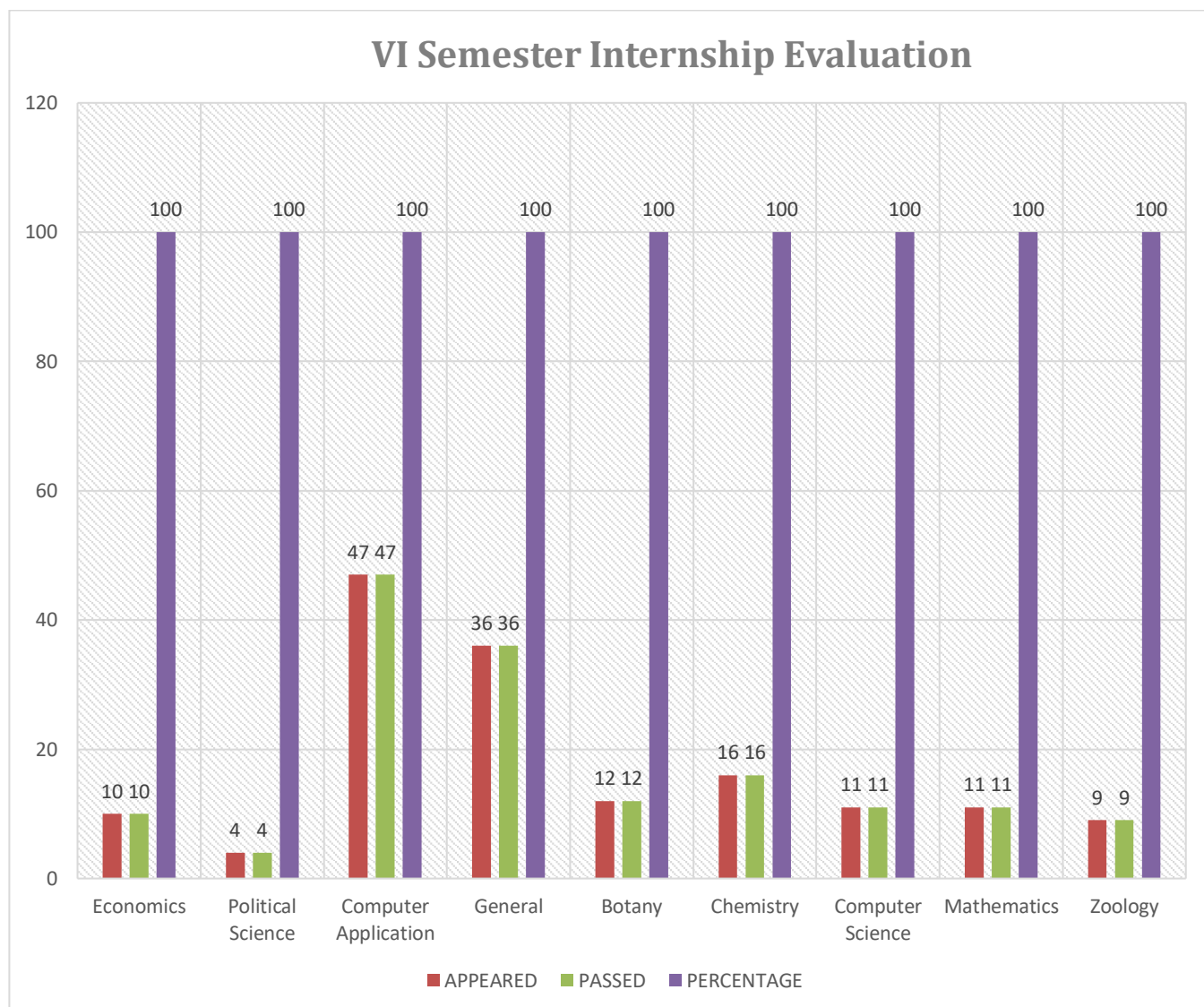

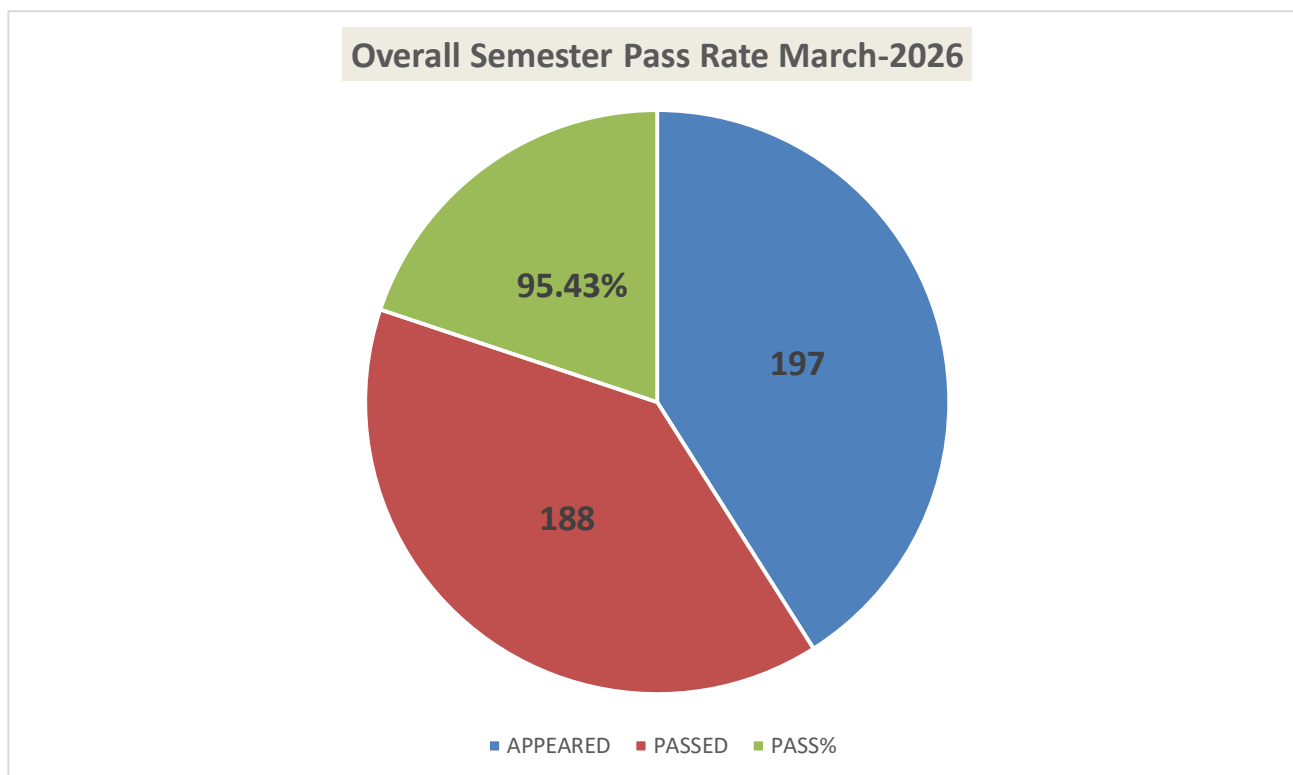
Variation of Arts and Science

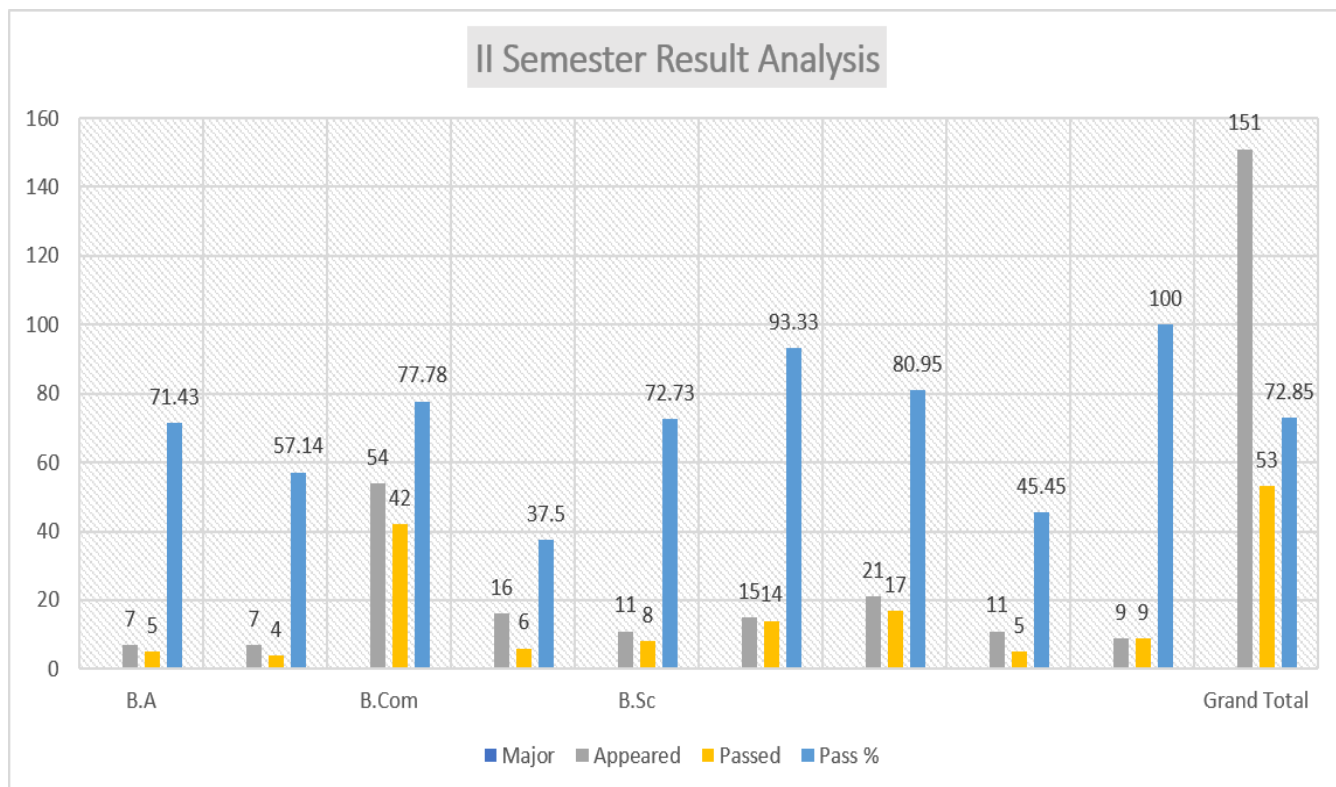

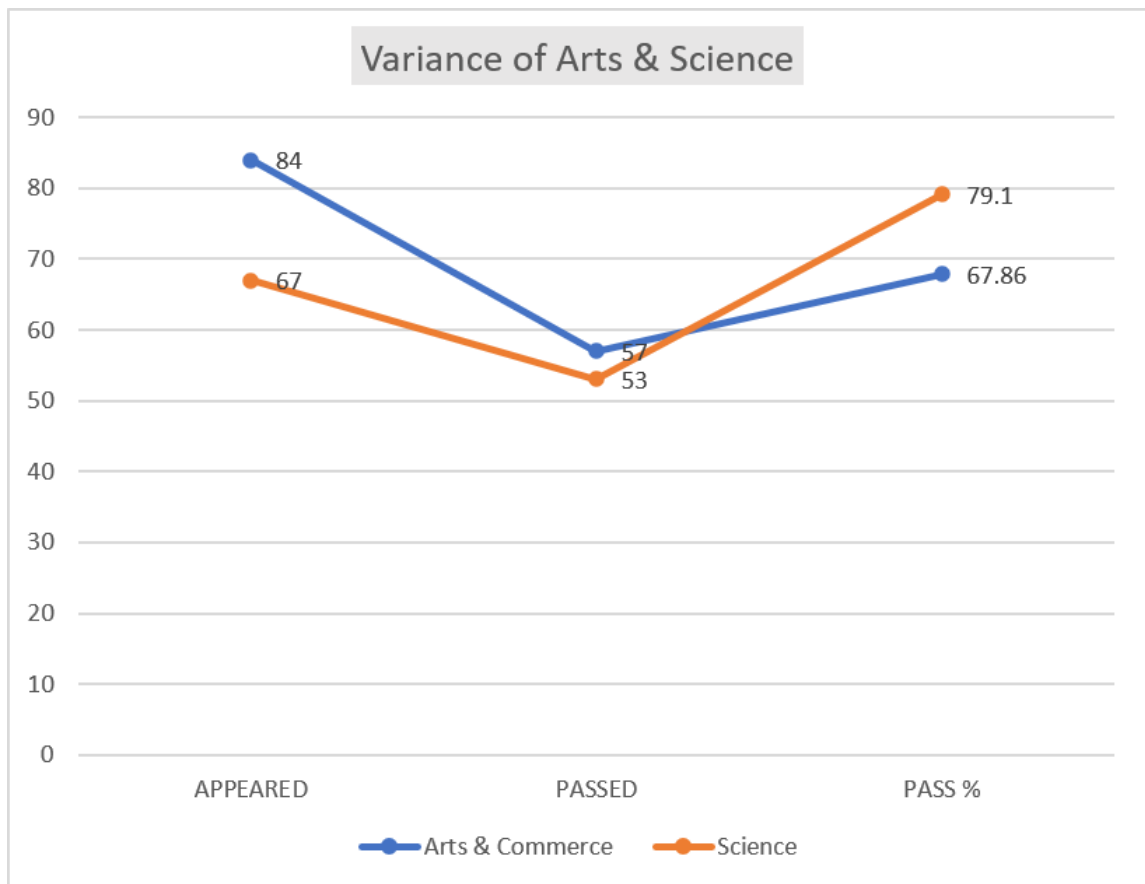

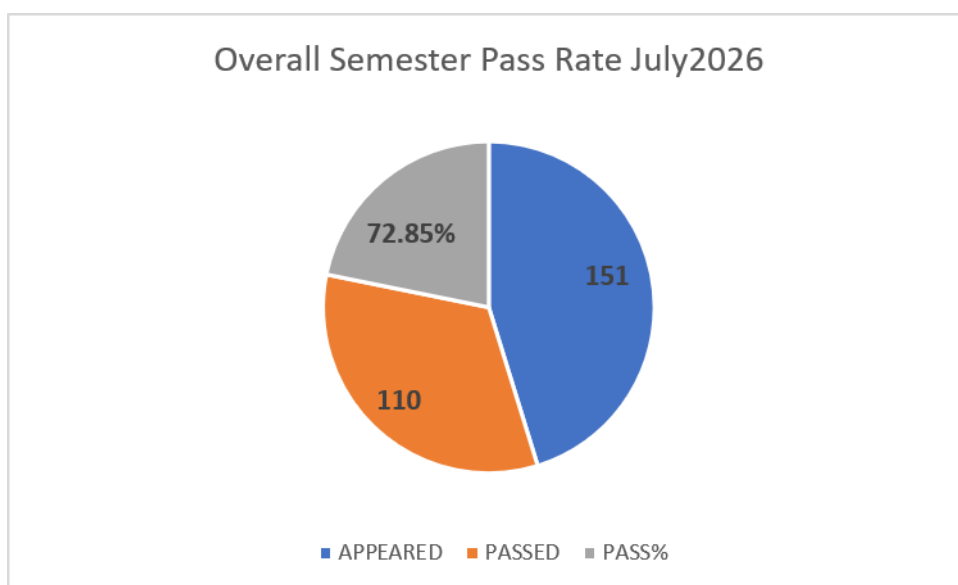
Variation of Arts and Science

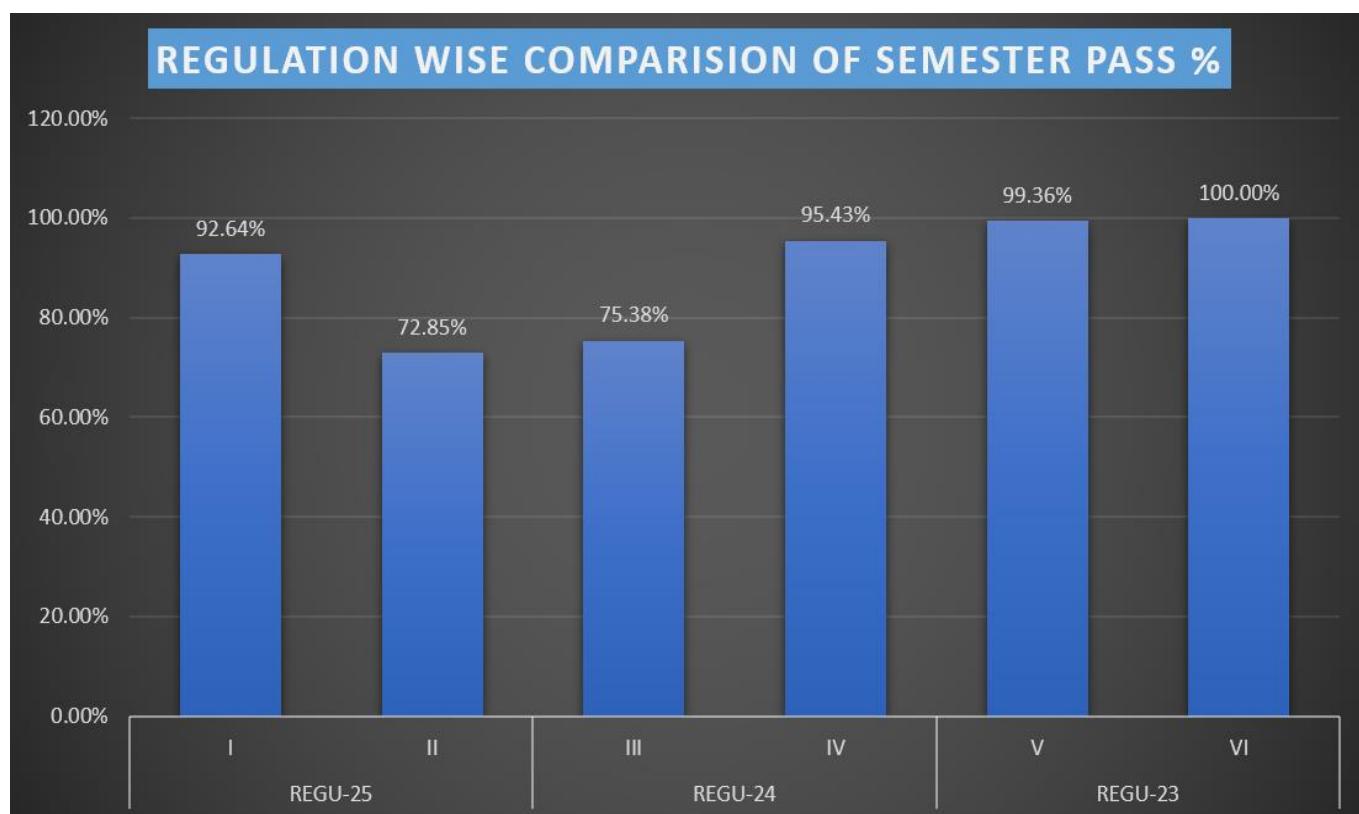

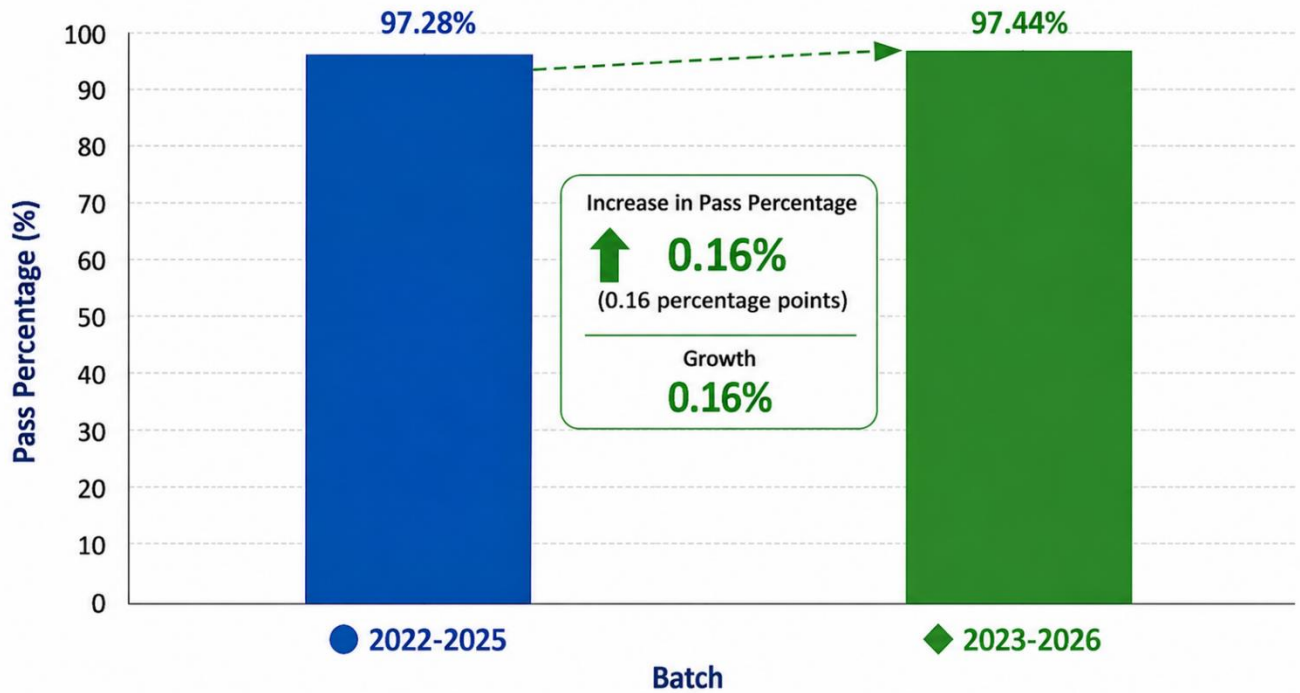
