(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as '**Parties**' and individually as '**Party**') as

WHEREAS:

- A) The first party is a Higher Educational Institution **Department of CHEMISTRY, Sri A.S.N.M GOVERNMENT COLLEGE (A), PALAKOL** and the second party is '**HIQ PHARMA LABS**' a professional body in the Pharmaceutical and healthcare Industry in all the functional areas such as Training, Manufacturing, Quality Control, Quality Assurance, Formulations Research & Development, Analytical Research & Development etc. They have two branches one at Masab Tank, Hyderabad in Telangana and the other is at Rajamahendravaram in AP.

**CLAUSE-1
CO-OPERATION**

The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.

**CLAUSE-2
SCOPE OF THE MoU**

2.1 INTERNSHIP:

Student exchange programs, internships, and industrial exposure opportunities shall be explored and implemented, wherever feasible, for the mutual benefit of both Parties.

Industrial orientation, skill development training, internships and placement assistance shall be provided for students of **SRI A.S.N.M GOVERNMENT COLLEGE (A), PALAKOL** where possible. Collaborative research activities and publications may be undertaken upon mutual



consent of the **SRI A.S.N.M GOVERNMENT COLLEGE (A)** faculty members and scientists of **HIQ PHARMA LABS** who are involved in the projects. Authorship and intellectual contributions shall be determined jointly in accordance with academic and ethical guidelines Any other mutually agreed form of cooperation.

2.2 GUEST LECTURES:

Both Parties shall extend necessary support for organizing guest lectures, and expert interactions for students and faculty

2.3 FIELD EXPOSURE:

Both Parties will give an insight into the latest developments/ requirements of the industries; the Second Party may permit the Faculty and Students of both Parties to visit its labs and fields and also involve in Training Programs for both Parties. Both parties will provide its Labs / Workshops / field Sites for the hands-on training of the students.

2.4 APPROVALS:

Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programs on the terms specified herein.

2.5 FINANCIAL COMMITMENT:

There is no financial commitment on the part of the Second party and the first party for the implementation of the activities mentioned in this MoU.

CLAUSE-3 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

3.1 Nothing contained in this MoU shall, by express grant, implication, estoppel' or otherwise, create in either party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copyrights and designs) of the other Party. This will be dealt separately as per NISP 2019 or the laws therein.

CLAUSE 4 VALIDITY

4.1 This MoU shall remain valid for a period of three (3) years from the date of execution, i.e., until **05 June 2029**, unless terminated earlier by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period '**HIQ PHARMA LABS**' the Second Party, as the case may be, will



take reasonable efforts for implementation of this MoU. Any act on the part of 'HIQ PHARMA LABS' the Second Party after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MoU.

- 4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MoU upon 90 calendar days' notice in writing. Upon termination, both Parties shall fulfill any obligations already undertaken prior to termination.

Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MoU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

CLAUSE-6
CONFIDENTIALITY

- 6.1 Both Parties agree to maintain confidentiality of any proprietary, academic, technical and research information shared during the period of collaboration and shall not disclose such information to any third party without prior written consent.

CLAUSE-7
NON-BINDING EFFECT

- 7.1 This MoU reflects the intent of cooperation between the Parties and does not create legally enforceable obligations, except where specifically agreed upon in writing by both Parties.
