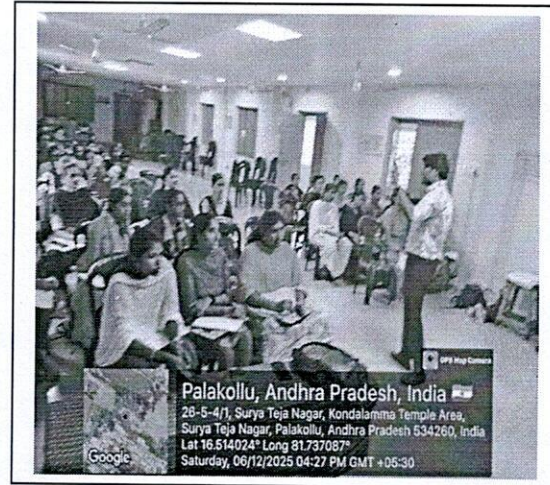
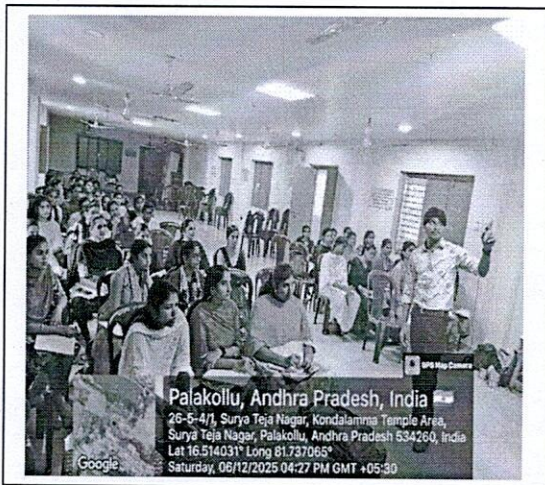


Day 1: I Am Unique, Body Language & Professional Grooming, English Language for Career Classes Explained by Naandi Foundation Trainer S. Eswara rao

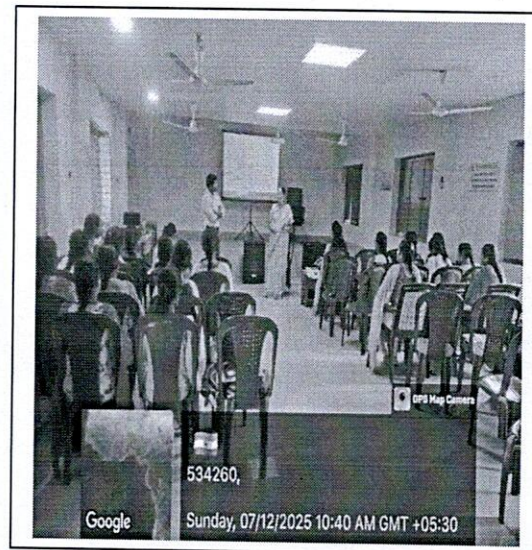
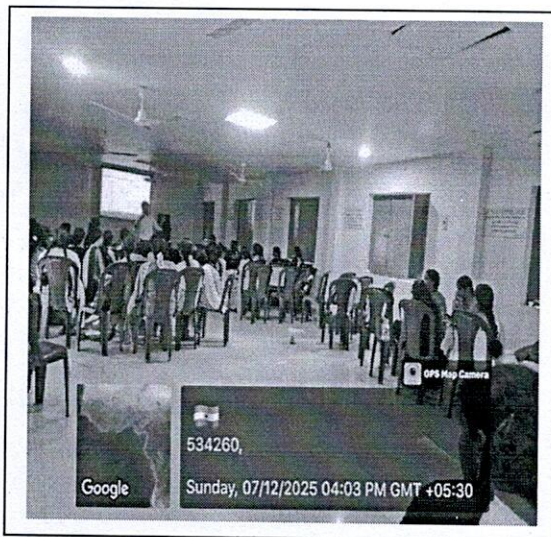


Day 2: Art of Speaking, Goal Setting & Time Management, Job Opportunities Classes Explained by Naandi Foundation Trainer S. Eswara rao

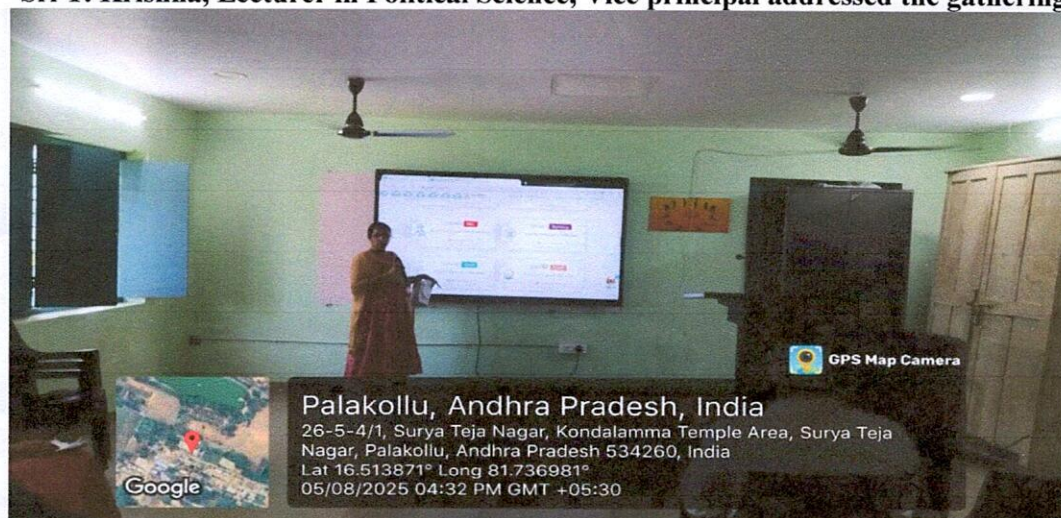
